## Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Mario MARTORELL (Peru)

1. At its 66th meeting, on 8 December 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/85) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A/36/L.19. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

2. The Fifth Committee decided without objection to inform the General Assembly, that, should it adopt draft resolution A/36/L.19, an additional appropriation of \$13,700 would be required under section 1 of the programme budget for 1982-1983. Additional conference-servicing costs not exceeding \$38,300 would arise which would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing costs for 1982 at a later stage during the current session.
