- 1. At its 67th meeting, on 8 December 1981, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/56 and Rev.1) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A/36/L.11/Rev.1 and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/36/7/Add.13). Further recommendations of the Advisory Committee were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/36/SR.67).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/36/L.11/Rev.1, additional appropriations of \$382,300, \$4,200, \$1,800, \$9,400, \$7,200, \$4,800, \$3,800 and \$30,000 would be required under sections 4 (Policy-making organs (economic and social activities)), 5A (Office of the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation), 10 (Economic Commission for Europe), 11 (Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific), 12 (Economic Commission for Latin America), 13 (Economic Commission for Africa), 14 (Economic Commission for Western Asia) and

28D (Office of General Services, Headquarters) respectively, of the proposed programme budget for 1982-1983. Provision of \$97,500 would also have to be made under section 31 (Staff assessment), to be offset by an increase in the same amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment). Additional conference-servicing costs not exceeding \$429,000 would arise, which would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing costs for 1982 to be submitted to the General Assembly at a later stage of the current session.
