Rule 6.6. Amicus curiae and other forms of submission

Rule 6.6 (a) should read:

“A Chamber of the Court may, if it considers it desirable for the proper determination of the case, invite or grant leave to a State, organization or person to submit, in writing or orally, any observation on any issue that the Chamber deems appropriate. **The Chamber shall in every case grant leave to a State to submit orally or in writing its observation concerning issues related to its national interest.**”
