## Corrigendum

Paragraph 84 should read

84. On 5 May, Indonesia and Portugal signed three agreements at United Nations Headquarters to enable the people of East Timor to decide if they wanted wide-ranging autonomy under Indonesian rule (see A/53/951–S/1999/513). Indonesia agreed to take the constitutional steps necessary to terminate its links with East Timor if the special autonomy option were rejected in the popular consultation (see para. 24 above). The agreements included annexes on security and voting arrangements.
