LETTER DATED 18 AUGUST 1999 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAO TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that over 1,400 unexploded mines, bombs, missiles and ordnance left behind after the 30-nation aggression against Iraq were found and dealt with in various parts of the country between 1 June and 31 July 1999. These explosive devices include missiles, cluster bombs, spherical bombs, tape bombs and mines which were found in the following governorates: Basra, Wasit, Dhi Qar, Ninawa, Najaf, Diyala, Muthanna, Salah al-Din, Qadisiyah, Karbala, Anbar and Ta'mim.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
