3. NEW DRAFT REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

The Committee will vote on the proposals under items 7.1. to 7.5. of part A of the agenda, taking account of the recommendations by the Working Party.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

A. Session of the Working Party

1. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

In accordance with the Commission's rules of procedure, the first item on the provisional agenda is the adoption of the agenda.

- 2. COORDINATION AND ORGANIZATION OF WORK
- 2.1. The Chairman of the Administrative Committee for the Coordination of Work (WP.29/AC.2) will report on the discussions held during its seventy-first session and submit its proposals for consideration by the Working Party.
- 2.2. WP.29 might wish to consider the Programme of Work and Priorities as proposed by the Administrative Committee (WP.29/AC.2) and by the Chairmen of its respective subsidiary Working Parties.
- 2.3. Following the adoption in principle by the Working Party at its one-hundred-and-eighteenth session (TRANS/WP.29/680, para. 31), the proposal for draft Terms of Reference and Rules of Procedure (TRANS/WP.29/1998/2/Rev.2 and TRANS/WP.29/680, annex 3) was consolidated by the secretariat into a single working document (TRANS/WP.29/1999/43). WP.29 may wish to proceed towards its final adoption, however, taking also into account the prospects for the entry into force of the Global Agreement of 25 June 1998 (TRANS/WP.29/680, para. 16).

3. GLOBAL HARMONIZATION

- 3.1. Following the adoption in principle at its one-hundred-and-eighteenth session (TRANS/WP.29/680, para. 33), WP.29 may wish to consider the introduction of its new name "World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29)" in conjunction with the prospects for the entry into force of the Global Agreement of 25 June 1998 (TRANS/WP.29/680, para. 16).
- 3.2. WP.29 may wish to review developments related to the Agreement of 25 June 1998, particularly with respect to new signatories.
- 3.3. WP.29 may wish to continue its consideration of the strategy for the future harmonization work (TRANS/WP.29/680, para. 44).
- 4. CONSIDERATION OF THE REPORTS OF THE WORKING PARTIES SUBSIDIARY TO WP.29
 - WP.29 may wish to consider and endorse the reports of GRE, GRSG, GRSP and GRPE. In addition, the Chairmen of GRRF, GRB, GRE and GRSG will report orally on the highlights of the recent sessions.

B. Session of the Administrative Committee (AC.1)

1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AC.1

The Administrative Committee shall be composed of all the Contracting Parties in accordance with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 of the Agreement (E/ECE/324-E/ECE/TRANS/505/Rev.2, Article 1, para. 2).

2. DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

Amendments to Regulations shall be established by the Administrative Committee according to the procedure indicated in Appendix 1. Proposed amendments to Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement applying the Regulation, shall have one vote. A quorum of not less than half of the Contracting Parties applying the Regulation is required for the purposes of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The

representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of those of its constituent sovereign countries which apply the Regulation. Draft amendments to Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Article 12 and Appendix 1).

Contracting Parties experiencing difficulties in attending the sessions of the Administrative Committee AC.1 might be allowed exceptionally to express their views on items considered in writing, or by delegation of their voting power to other Contracting Parties attending the session (TRANS/WP.29/482, para. 11).

If all Contracting Parties to the Agreement agree, any Regulation adopted under the terms of the unamended Agreement may be treated as though it was a Regulation adopted under the terms of the amended Agreement (Article 15, para. 3).

3. NEW DRAFT REGULATIONS - VOTING BY AC.1

The Contracting Parties shall establish, through an Administrative Committee made up of all the Contracting Parties in conformity with the rules of procedure set out in Appendix 1 and on the basis of the following articles and paragraphs, Regulations for wheeled vehicles, equipment and parts which can be fitted and/or be used on wheeled vehicles (Article 1, para. 1).

Proposed new Regulations shall be put to the vote. Each country, Contracting Party to the Agreement, shall have one vote. A quorum consisting of not less than one-half of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement is required for the purpose of taking decisions. For the determination of the quorum, regional economic integration organizations, being Contracting Parties to the Agreement, vote with the number of votes of their Member States. The representative of a regional economic integration organization may deliver the votes of its constituent sovereign countries. New Draft Regulations shall be established by a two-thirds majority of those present and voting (Appendix 1, Article 5).
