Development of Africa: implementation and coordinated follow-up by the United Nations system of initiatives on African development

The Economic and Social Council, having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the theme "Development of Africa: implementation and coordinated follow-up by the United Nations system of initiatives on African development", 1/ taking note of General Assembly resolution 53/92 of 7 December 1998 on the causes of conflict and the promotion of durable peace and sustainable development in Africa and noting the efforts made at various levels of the United Nations system in the follow-up and implementation of the initiatives and the efforts of the African Governments in this regard, recommends that the agreed conclusions and the discussion arising out of the coordination segment at the present session on the item be an integral part of the reports and issues to be considered by the open-ended working group to be established by the General Assembly at its fifty-fourth session.
