REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVES AND DEPUTY AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL ELECTED FOR THE PERIOD 1982-1983

At its 35th meeting on 15 October 1981, the General Assembly elected Guyana, Jordan, Poland, Togo and Zaire non-permanent members of the Security Council for a term of two years, beginning on 1 January 1982.

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that, with regard to the representation of the members of the Security Council elected for the period 1982-1983, he has received the communications referred to hereunder.

Guyana. The Secretary-General has received a telegram dated 31 December 1981 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Guyana stating that Mr. Noel Sinclair has been appointed representative of Guyana on the Security Council, Mr. David Karran deputy representative and Miss Elaine Jacob, Mr. Tyrone Ferguson and Mr. Donald Thomas alternate representatives. In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this communication constitutes adequate provisional credentials.

Poland. The Secretary-General has received credentials signed on 13 November 1981 by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Poland stating that Mr. Eugeniusz Wyzner has been appointed representative of Poland on the Security Council. In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order. The Secretary-General has also received a letter dated 17 December 1981 from the Permanent Representative of Poland to the United Nations stating that Mr. Jerzy Nowak and Mr. Ryszard Krystosik have been appointed deputy representatives of Poland on the Security Council and Mr. Jozef Soltysiewicz alternate representative. In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this letter constitutes adequate provisional credentials.

Togo. The Secretary-General has received credentials signed on 23 November 1981 by the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Co-operation of Togo stating that Mr. Atsu-Koffi Amega has been appointed representative of Togo on the Security Council, Mr. Koffi Adjoyi deputy representative and Mr. Glidjito Akakpo alternate representative. In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.

Zaire. The Secretary-General has received credentials from the President of Zaire signed on 28 November 1981 stating that Mr. Kamanda wa Kamanda has been appointed representative of Zaire on the Security Council, Mr. Nguayila Abela Kalanda deputy representative and Mr. Mapango ma Kemishanga, Mr. Tshamala N'Ji Lamule and Mr. Kabeya Milambu alternate representatives. In the opinion of the Secretary-General, these credentials are in order.
