## MISCELLANEOUS DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO THE MODEL REGULATIONS ON THE TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS

## Packagings

Paragraph 4.1.3.4

## IBCs for substances liable to become liquid during transport

## Background

1. The UN-Committee introduced in December 1998 the following new paragraph 4.1.3.4 :
"4.1.3.4 The following packagings shall not be used when the substances being transported are liable to become liquid during transport :

Boxes :
Bags :

2. The aim of this paragraph is to refuse - for the transport of substances liable to become liquid during transport - packagings and IBCs of the types that are only permitted for the transport of solids.
3. However, liquids of packing group I may not be transported in any type of IBC. As a result of this, the principle that has been applied to packagings and to IBCs for substances of packing groups II and III, has not been followed for IBCs with substances of packing group I. Packing group I substances that are liable to become liquid during transport should not be accepted in any type of IBC.

## Proposal

4. $\quad$ Change the last part of paragraph 4.1.3.4 as follows :

For substances of packing groups II and III :
