Senate Joint Resolution No. 37, SD1, SD2

A SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

Requesting the President of the Republic of Palau to conduct another round of negotiations regarding definite compensation and rental arrangements for the proposed land for military use.

WHEREAS, the Compact of Free Association has been initialed by Palau and United States negotiation teams; and

WHEREAS, in the Compact, more than forty-two thousand acres of land are proposed or designated for military use; and

WHEREAS, there are no definite fees or rental arrangements provided in the Compact of Free Association; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the President of the Republic of Palau to initiate another round of negotiations in order to set definite fees or rental arrangements for these proposed sites for military use; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the First Olbiil Era Kelulau, third special session, 1981, the House of Delegates concurring, that the President of the Republic of Palau is hereby respectfully requested to conduct or initiate another round of negotiations regarding fees and rental arrangements for proposed sites for military use in Palau; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Joint Resolution be transmitted to the President of the Republic of Palau, the head of the new United States negotiation team, the High Commissioner of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, the President of the United States of America, and the President of the Trusteeship Council of the United Nations.
