Note by the Secretary-General

1. By a communication dated 18 December 1981, addressed to States Parties to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, the Secretary-General drew attention to the vacancy in the International Court of Justice caused by the death of Judge Abdullah El-Erian (Egypt) on 12 December 1981. In the same communication, the Secretary-General, in accordance with Article 5 of the Statute of the Court, invited national groups to undertake the nomination of persons in a position to accept the duties of a member of the Court. The Secretary-General further requested that nominations should be received by 18 February 1982. Those nominations thus received have appeared in document A/36/862-S/14886 and Corr.1 and Add.l.
