SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF
WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE
REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/14840 of 19 January 1982.

During the week ending 20 March 1982, the Security Council took no action on any of the items listed therein.

During that week, however, at its 2333rd meeting, held on 19 March 1982, pursuant to resolution 499 (1981) of 21 December 1981, the Security Council proceeded to the election of a member of the International Court of Justice to fill the seat which had become vacant as a result of the death, on 12 December 1981, of Judge Abdullah El-Erian.

In the course of the voting, Mr. Mohammed Bedjaoui (Algeria) received the required majority of votes in the Security Council.

As Mr. Mohammed Bedjaoui also received the required majority of votes in the General Assembly, he was declared elected a member of the International Court of Justice for a term of office expiring on 5 February 1988.
