#### GENERAL INFORMATION NOTICE FOR PARTICIPANTS

#### Date and venue of the plenary session

1. At the invitation of the Swiss Federal Statistical Office (SFSO), which the Conference of European Statisticians accepted at its 1998 plenary session, the 1999 plenary session of the Conference will take place in Neuchâtel from 14 to 16 June 1999. The Conference will be held at the Cantonal Parliament House, Château, 2001 Neuchâtel.

#### Visas for entry in Switzerland

2. Anyone planning to attend the plenary session who requires a visa to enter Switzerland should contact the Swiss embassy or consulate in their country to obtain the visa. When requesting the visa, they should specify on their application that the purpose of their journey is to participate in the 1999 UN/ECE meeting of the Conference of European Statisticians which will take place at the Swiss Federal Statistical Office (SFSO)in Neuchâtel. Participants may also use the official invitation letter sent to them by the SFSO for that purpose.

## Transportation to and from Neuchâtel

#### By train:

- 3. There are direct train connections between Zurich Airport and Neuchâtel and also between Geneva Airport and Neuchâtel. The trip from Zurich lasts about two and one-half hours, and the one from Geneva lasts about one and one-half hours. There is also a TGV line that directly links Paris and Neuchâtel (about a 4 hour trip).
- 4. There is a train that leaves Zurich airport and Geneva airport for Neuchâtel once every hour. The current schedules are shown in the Annex. It should be noted, however, that these schedules are subject to change. Neuchâtel is also accessible by train from Basel and Bern which have international airports. ## By road:

Highway A5 Geneva - Neuchâtel (128km) Highway A1 Zurich-Berne-Morat, continuation on semi-highway to Neuchâtel (150km)

## Transportation in Neuchâtel

- 5. From the train station, participants may reach the Château where the Conference will meet either by taxi, on foot (a 15 minute walk) or by taking the bus. Participants who decide to travel by bus should take a Number 6 bus from the train station (Direction Place Pury) to the stop called "Place Pury", then walk uphill from there to the Château, and follow the brown signs indicating the direction to take to reach the "Château/Collégiale". It is recommended that participants not travel by car as there is a very limited number of parking spaces in the vicinity of the Chateau.
- 6. The SFSO building is situated next to the train station.
- 7. Most hotels are within walking distance from the Château or from the SFSO building.

## Registration

8. Participants will be issued a Conference badge when they register at the Registration Desk upon their arrival at the Château. To facilitate this process, it is important that countries inform the ECE Secretariat (Fax 4122 917-0040; e-mail: conference.stat@unece.org) at least two weeks prior to the meeting who the participants will be. Delegates should arrive at the Chateau about 30-45 minutes before the session is scheduled to start in order to allow time for all the participants to register.

9. Participants will be asked to complete the registration forms at the registration desk, prior to the commencement of the plenary session. These forms will also be used as the basis for preparing the provisional list of participants.

## Official languages of the session

10. The meeting room will be equiped with simultaneous interpretation equipment, and interpretation will be provided into and from the three official working languages of the UN/ECE (English, French and Russian).

#### Coffee

17. During coffee breaks, tea and coffee will be offered by the SFSO during the Conference.

#### Restaurants

18. The Château does not have a cafeteria or restaurant on the premises. However, there are several restaurants in the vicinity of the Chateau. Participants will also be provided with a list of restaurants in the old town of Neuchâtel that are within walking distance of the Château.

#### Hotel and travel arrangements

- 19. Participants are requested to make their own travel and hotel arrangements. Travel and hotel costs will have to be met by the participants themselves. Participants will have to pay for their hotel rooms directly before their departure.
- 20. It is recommended that participants make their hotel reservations <u>as soon as possible</u> as the demand for hotel accommodation in June in Neuchâtel is usually very high.
- 21. The Congress Service of the Tourism Office in Neuchâtel has a list of hotels of various classes available, and will make reservations for Conference participants at discount prices at the hotels of their choice. In order to benefit from these preferential rates, participants have to use the hotel registration form presented in Annex II and send it to the Congress Service. - 23. On Tuesday 15 June evening, the SFSO is inviting the participants to the reception it will offer in its new premises in Neuchâtel. During the apéritif that will precede, interested participants may also have a guided tour of the building. On the ground floor, they will discover the exhibition the SFSO will be hosting throughout 1999, which celebrates the new population size of 6 billion persons the world population reached this year.

24. Finally, for interested participants and accompanying persons, a brochure on activities in the city and region of Neuchâtel will also be made available by the SFSO. 25. Monday evening will be free. For those participants interested, it is also possible to organise at their own cost an evening excursion/dinner in the nearly hills above Neuchâtel, from where one has the most striking view over the three connecting lakes (funicular railways, panoramic tower and restaurant). However, this possibility will depend on the number of participants, and it will be necessary to make special reservation in advance for such an event. The SFSO therefore asks participants to indicate on the inscription sheet (hotel reservation) if they would like to take advantage of this opportunity.

#### Other practical information

#### Post and bank

There are several banks and post offices in the centre of Neuchâtel, within easy walking distance of the Château and most hotels. The Central Post Office is situated in front of the train station. The main post office downtown is the "Hôtel des postes", where the Tourism Office is also located.

Opening hours for post offices are Monday-Friday 07.30-18.30 (Saturday 08.00-11.00), and for banks they are Monday-Friday 08.15/9.00-16.30 (17.30 on Thursdays). There is also a money change office in the railway station that operates from 06.00-21.00 seven days a week.
