NOTE VERBALE DATED 5 MAY 1982 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
DENMARK TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Denmark to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note of 27 February 1978 circulated as Security Council document S/12510/Add.1 of 1 March 1978, whereby the Secretary-General was informed that a special Royal Decree with a view to ensuring strict and full compliance with Security Council resolution 418 (1977) of 4 November 1977 entered into force on 10 February 1978.

The Permanent Representative of Denmark now has the honour to inform the Secretary-General that the Royal Decree has been amended in order to widen the scope of its application. The Amendment entered into force on 20 April 1982.

The enclosed copy of the Royal Decree on Amendment is forwarded for the information of the Secretary-General.

The Permanent Representative of Denmark has the honour to request that this communication be issued as a document of the Security Council.

Decree on Amendment of the Decree on Certain
Measures against South Africa*

We, Margrethe II, by the Grace of God Queen of Denmark, make known:

Pursuant to section 1 of Act No. 156 of May 10, 1967, on Certain Measures in Pursuance of the United Nations Charter and after consultations with the Foreign Affairs Committee the following provisions shall be introduced:

1. Royal Decree No. 40 of February 3, 1978, on Certain Measures against South Africa shall be amended as follows:

In section 1, insert the following subsection 3:

"1.3. A ship's master who has been instructed to call at South Africa shall, where his cargo comprises any of the items listed under 1.1. above, inform his shipowner accordingly and await new instructions from him."

2. This Decree shall enter into force on the date of its publication in the Government Gazette (LOVTIDENDE).
