Appointment of a member of the Board of Auditors

Note by the Secretary-General

1. As indicated in the note by the Secretary-General of 15 July 1999 (A/54/103), the General Assembly will be required, during its current session, to appoint the Auditor-General, or officer holding the equivalent title, of a Member State to fill the vacancy that will occur in the membership of the United Nations Board of Auditors on 1 July 2000.
 2. The Government of South Africa has nominated the Auditor-General of the Republic of South Africa for appointment to the United Nations Board of Auditors for a term of office beginning on 1 July 2000 and ending on 30 June 2003.
