Ireland: draft resolution

The Security Council,

 $\frac{\text{Recalling}}{\text{June 1982}}$ its resolutions 425 (1978) of 19 March 1978 and 508 (1982) of 5 June 1982,

<u>Gravely concerned</u> at the situation as described by the Secretary-General in his report to the Council,

<u>Reaffirming</u> the need for strict respect for the territorial integrity, sovereignty and political independence of Lebanon within its internationally recognized boundaries,

1. <u>Demands</u> that Israel withdraw all its military forces forthwith and unconditionally to the internationally recognized boundaries of Lebanon;

2. <u>Demands</u> that all parties observe strictly the terms of paragraph 1 of resolution 508 (1982) which called on them to cease immediately and simultaneously all military activities within Lebanon and across the Lebanese-Israeli border;

3. <u>Calls</u> on all parties to communicate to the Secretary-General their acceptance of the present resolution within 24 hours;

4. Decides to remain seized of the question.
