APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Appointment of three members and three alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Article 6 of the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund provides as follows:

"Article 6

Staff Pension Committee

- "(a) The United Nations Staff Pension Committee shall consist of three members and three alternate members elected by the General Assembly. ...
- "(b) The elected members and alternate members of the Committee shall hold office for three years or until the election of their successors and shall be eligible for re-elections; in the event that such a member or alternate member ceases, during his term of office, to be a member of the Committee, another member or alternate member may be elected to hold office during the remainder of his term.

"(c) ... "

2. The present members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee, appointed by the General Assembly for terms of office expiring on 31 December 1982, are the following:

Alternate members:

- 3. Accordingly, it will be necessary for the General Assembly at its thirty-seventh session to elect three members and three alternate members to the Committee to serve for a period of three years, beginning on 1 January 1983.
- 4. At previous sessions, the Fifth Committee submitted to the General Assembly a draft decision containing the names of the persons recommended for appointment. It is suggested that a similar procedure be followed at the thirty-seventh session.
