LETTER DATED 13 APRIL 1982 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ISRAEL TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to my letter to you dated 12 April 1982 (S/14965), I would like to draw your urgent attention to yet another attempt by the terrorist PLO to infiltrate into Israel in order to inflict the maximum casualties on Israel civilians.

On the night between 12 and 13 April 1982, two PLO terrorists infiltrated from Jordanian territory into the Jordan Valley north of Argaman. They set up a road block on the main road and threw grenades on a passing vehicle. An Israel Defence Forces patrol pursued the two terrorists, who fled across the Jordan River into Jordanian territory. This is the second attempt in the last few days of Yasser Arafat's <u>Fatah</u>, the major constituent group operating under the PLO umbrella, to infiltrate into Israel.

Your Excellency will no doubt appreciate the extreme seriousness with which my Government views these attempts.

I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
