LETTER DATED 30 MAY 1982 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
JORDAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour, upon instructions from my Government, to request an immediate convening of the Security Council, to consider the prolonged, on-going and grave armed conflict which has been raging and intensifying between the Republic of Iraq and the Islamic Republic of Iran, since September of 1980.

The conflict is assuming ever-widening dimensions which pose an imminent danger not only to regional peace, but to world peace and security in general.

It is the most earnest hope of my Government that the Security Council would shoulder its responsibilities in this grave situation.
