## Annex

Letter dated 5 August 1982 from the Permanent Observer of the the Palestine Liberation Organization to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I am instructed by Yasser Arafat, Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Palestine Liberation Organization, to transmit the following:

"International observers are supposed to arrive, though none have arrived as yet. Their arrival is very important, especially in view of the continued Israeli military build-up. It is imperative that they come as soon as possible. We are awaiting your answer tonight."

As you know, the Palestine Liberation Organization has already reaffirmed its commitment to the ceasefire, as was reported by the Secretary-General in Document S/15345.

We have also noted that, in Paragraph 7 of the same document, observers have established the positions of the Israeli forces of invasion. In this respect, we wish to recall Operative paragraph 4 of Resolution 517 (1982). We trust that the Security Council will take prompt action to consider the response and the action taken by the parties to the conflict.
