STATEMENT BY VIET NAM NEWS AGENCY

According to Western reports, the Thai Foreign Ministry recently sent a note to United Nations Secretary-General Javier Perez de Cuellar slanderously charging that Vietnamese aircraft and fishing trawlers had violated Thailand's airspace and territorial waters in May and June last.

Viet Nam News Agency is authorized to declare that this is sheer fabrication and that Viet Nam always respects the sovereignty, security and territorial integrity of Thailand.

The above-mentioned fabrication and slander only do harm to the atmosphere of dialogue between Viet Nam and Thailand reached through the meeting between the Foreign Ministers of the two countries late last month.
