## Decision adopted by the Committee on Disarmament on the establishment of an ad hoc working group, under item 1 of its agenda entitled "Muclear Test Ban"

In the exercise of its responsibilities as the multilateral disarmament negotiating forum in accordance with paragraph 220 of the Final Document of the first special session of the General Assembly devoted to disarmament, the Committee on Disarmament decides to establish an <u>ad noc</u> working group under item 1 of its agenda entitled "Nuclear Test Ban".

Considering that discussion of specific issues in the first instance may facilitate progress toward negotiation of a nuclear test can, the Committee requests the <u>ad hoc</u> working group to discuss and define, through substantive examination, issues relating to verification and compliance with a view to making further progress toward a nuclear test ban.

The <u>ad hoc</u> working group will take into account all existing proposals and future initiatives, and will report to the Committee on the progress of its work before the conclusion of the 1982 session. The Committee will thereafter take a decision on subsequent courses of action with a view to fulfilling its responsibilities in this regard.
