## STATUS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS Report of the Secretary-General

- At its thirty-seventh session, the Commission on Human Rights had before it a note by the Secretary-General (E/CN.4/1444) on the status of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, and the Optional Frotocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.
- By its resolution 16 (XXXVII) of 10 March 1981, the Commission reaffirmed the importance of the International Covenants on Human Rights as major parts of international efforts to promote universal respect for and observance of human rights and fundamental freedoms; again urged all States which had not yet done so to become parties to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights as well as to consider acceding to the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights; invited the States parties to the International Covenant on Cavil and Political Rights to consider making the declaration provided for in article 41 of that Covenant: and requested the Secretary-General to submit to the Commission on Human Rights at its thirty-eighth session a report on the status of the International Covenants on Human Rights and on the Optional Protocol and to include in this report information on the work of the Economic and Social Council and its Working Group on the implementation of the International Covenant on Economio, Social and Cultural Rights. The present report was prepared in response to that request.
- 5. Since the adoption by the Commission of resolution 16 (XXXVII), the two Covenants were ratified or acceded to by the Central African Republic, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Mexico and Saint Vincent and the Grenalines, and Honduras ratified the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights thus bringing the number of ratifications or accessions, as at 31 December 1981, to 71 for the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cutural Rights and to 69 for the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights. The list of States that had signed, ratified or acceded to the Covenants, as well as the dates of their signature,

ratification or accession, may be found in annexes I and II. Also indicated in annex II are the 14 States parties which have so far made the declaration under article 41 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, recognizing the competence of the Human Rights Committee to receive and consider communications to the effect that a State party claims that another State party is not fulfilling its obligations under the Covenant. The provisions of article 41 entered into force on 28 March 1979 in accordance with paragraph 2 of that article.

- 4. In addition, the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights was acceded to by the Central African Republic and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines. As of 31 December 1981, 27 States parties to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights had also become parties to the Protocol. The list of States that had signed, ratified or acceded to the Protocol, as well as the dates of their signature, ratification or accession, may be found in annex III.
- 5. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the Sessional Working Group on the Implementation of that Covenant, established in accordance with Economic and Social Council decision 1978/10 of 3 May 1978, held its third session at United Nations Headquarters from 14 April to 1 May 1981. It considered reports submitted by States parties under the first and second stages of the programme established by Council resolution 1988 (LX) concerning rights covered by articles 6 to 9, and 10 to 12, of the Covenant respectively. It also considered the question of the review of its future composition, organization and administrative arrangements in accordance with Council resolution 1980/24 and decision 1981/102, and submitted a report to the Economic and Social Council at its first regular session of 1981 (E/1981/64 and Add.1).
- 6. By its decision 1981/158, the Economic and Social Council took note of the report of the Sessional Working Group; approved the recommendations of the Group concerning its composition, organization and administrative arrangements; and decided to incorporate those recommendations into the methods of work of the Sessional Working Group as set out in Council resolution 1979/43 of 11 May 1979. By its decision 1981/159, the Council decided to request States parties to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural lights which have not yet submitted their reports as called for under article 16 of the Covenant and Council resolution 1988 (LX), to do so as soon as possible; and, by decision 1981/162, it decided to further review the composition, organization and administrative arrangements of the Sessional Working Group at its first regular session of 1982.
- 7. The General Assembly in its resolution 36/58 of 25 November 1981 took note of Economic and Social Council decision 1981/162 of 8 May 1981 concerning the review of the composition, organization and administrative arrangements of the Sessional Working Group of Governmental Experts on the implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and looked forward to further results in this regard at the first regular session of the Council in 1982.
- 8. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Human Rights Committee held its eleventh session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 20 to 31 October 1980, its twelfth session at United Nations Headquarters from 23 March to 10 April 1981 and its thirteenth session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 13 to 31 July 1981. In accordance with article 45 of the Covenant and article 6 of the Optional Protocol, the Committee submitted its fifth annual report, through the Economic and Social Council, to the

General Assembly at its thirty-sixth session, 1/ which covers the activities of the Committee at its eleventh, twelfth and thirteenth sessions.

- 9. The Committee also held its fourteenth session at Bonn from 12 to 30 October 1981 at the invitation of the Federal Republic of Germany. Following a decision of the Committee at its fifth session to adopt its annual reports at the end of its summer sessions for appropriate transmission to the General Assembly, through the Economic and Social Council, in compliance with the requirement of article 45 of the Covenant, the activities of the Committee at its fourteenth session will be covered in its next annual report.
- 10. In its resolution 36/58 of 25 November 1981, the General Assembly recognizing the important role of the Human Rights Committee in the implementation of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the Optional Protocol thereto, expressed its appreciation to the States parties to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights which have extended their co-operation to the Human Rights Committee when submitting their reports under article 40 of the Covenant; urged States parties which have not yet done so to submit their reports to the Committee as speedily as possible; took note of the decisions of the Human Rights Committee on the question of periodicity and on guidelines regarding the form and content of reports from States parties under article 40, paragraph 1 (b), of the Covenant as well as the adoption by the Committee of general comments under article 40, paragraph 4, of the Covenant; again invited all States which have not yet done so to become parties to both Covenants on Human Rights and to the Optional Protocol; requested the Secretary-General to continue to keep the Human Rights Committee informed of the activities of the Commission on Human Rights, the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities and the Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination and also to transmit the annual reports of the Human Rights Committee to these bodies; and welcomed the measures taken by the Secretary-General to improve the publicity for the work of the Human Rights Committee and requested him to consider the most appropriate steps for the publication of the Committee's documentation and to report on this question to the General Assembly at its thirty-seventh session. In accordance with Assembly resolution 36/58, the fifth annual report of the Committee (A/36/40) will be made available to the Commission at its thirty-eighth session.
