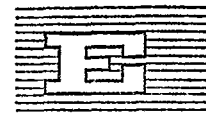

SOME PROPOSALS FOR INSERTION IN THE  
PREAMBLE TO THE DRAFT DECLARATION

Working paper submitted by Iraq

1. Reference to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights:

"Considering that, under the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, everyone is entitled to realization, through national effort and international co-operation and in accordance with the resources of each State, of the economic, social and cultural rights indispensable for his dignity and the free development of his personality".

2. References to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights and the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights:

"Recognizing that by virtue of the right of self-determination all peoples have the right freely to determine their political status and freely to pursue their economic, social and cultural development".

3. The preamble should also refer to or cite the following international instruments:

- A. The Declaration on Social Progress and Development (11 December 1969);
- B. The Declaration on the Use of Scientific and Technological Progress in the Interests of Peace and for the Benefit of Mankind (10 November 1975);
- C. The Charter of Economic Rights and Duties of States (General Assembly resolution 3281 (XXIX)).
