LETTER DATED 24 AUGUST 1982 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ARGENTINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour, in pursuance of my note of 13 August (S/15361), to keep the Security Council informed of further developments which occurred in waters under Argentine jurisdiction on 14 and 15 August.

In this case the fishing vessel <u>Harengus</u> and the Argentine-registered factory ships <u>Usurbil</u>, <u>Albamar II</u>, <u>Kasuga Maru</u> and <u>Rokko Maru</u> were overflown and buzzed by Sikorsky helicopters bearing British identification while they were outside the so-called "protection zone" arbitrarily declared by the United Kingdom, in acts of harassment which, moreover, are conducive to situations which endanger the safety of the fishing vessels.

I request that this letter be distributed as a document of the Security Council.
