Jordan: draft resolution

The Security Council,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General of 15 September 1982 (S/15382/Add.1),

Having listened to the statement by the Permanent Representative of Lebanon,

Taking note of Lebanon's determination to ensure the withdrawal of all non-Lebanese forces from Lebanon,

Calling again for the strict respect for Lebanon's sovereignty, territorial integrity, unity, and political independence,

- 1. <u>Condemns</u> the murder of Bashir Gemayel, Lebanon's constitutionally selected President-elect, and every effort to disrupt by violence the restoration of a strong, stable government in Lebanon;
- 2. Reaffirms its resolutions 508 (1982) and 509 (1982), and in particular, its call upon all the parties to the conflict to cease immediately and simultaneously all military activities within Lebanon and across the Lebanese-Israel border;
- 3. Condemns the recent Israeli incursions into Beirut in violation of the ceasefire agreements and of Security Council resolutions;
- 4. <u>Demands</u> an immediate return to the positions occupied by Israel before 15 September 1982, pending the full implementation of Security Council resolutions;
- 5. <u>Calls upon</u> all Governments who are in a position to do so to continue to exercise their best efforts to ensure the implementation of the present resolution and other pertinent resolutions of the Council;
- 6. Decides to remain seized of the question and asks the Secretary-General to keep the Council informed on developments.
