Report of the Fifth Committee

I. Introduction

1. The previous recommendation made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 123 appears in the report of the Committee contained in document A/54/507.
2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 9th, 12th and 22nd meetings, on 19 and 20 October and 2 November 1999. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/54/SR.9, 12 and 22).
3. In addition to the documents listed in A/54/507, the Committee had before it the report of the Joint Inspection Unit for the period from 1 July 1997 to 31 December 1998¹ and the report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the recommendations of the Unit (A/54/223).
4. At the 9th meeting, on 19 October, the Chairman of the Joint Inspection Unit made a statement and introduced the report of the Unit.¹

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/54/L.13

5. At the 22nd meeting, on 2 November, the Chairman of the Committee, following informal consultations, introduced a draft decision (A/C.5/54/L.13) entitled "Joint Inspection Unit".

6. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/54/L.13 without a vote (see para. 7).

III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

7. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Joint Inspection Unit

The General Assembly:

(a) Takes note of the report of the Joint Inspection Unit for the period from 1 July 1997 to 31 December 1998,² the programme of work of the Unit for 1999 and the preliminary listing of potential reports for 2000 and beyond³ and the report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the recommendations of the Joint Inspection Unit;⁴

(b) Requests the Secretary-General to improve further the quality, including the conciseness and clarity, of the reports on the implementation of the recommendations of the Joint Inspection Unit.
