ELECTIONS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS
AND OTHER ELECTIONSElection of seven members of the Committee for Programme
and Co-ordinationNote by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with paragraph 7 of the terms of reference of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination (Economic and Social Council resolution 2008 (LX) of 14 May 1976, annex), the members of the Committee are nominated by the Economic and Social Council and elected by the General Assembly for a term of three years.
2. The membership of the Committee in 1982 is as follows (see General Assembly decision 36/315):

Argentina,* Brazil,** Costa Rica,* France,* Germany, Federal Republic of,***
India,** Japan,** Morocco,** Netherlands,*** Pakistan,*** Philippines,**
Romania,*** Senegal,** Sudan,* Trinidad and Tobago,*** Union of Soviet
Socialist Republics,* United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland,***
United Republic of Cameroon,** United Republic of Tanzania,* United States of
America* and Yugoslavia.***

3. The General Assembly, at its thirty-seventh session, will therefore be called upon to elect seven members, on the nomination of the Economic and Social Council, to fill the vacancies in the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination which will occur as a result of the expiration of the terms of office of Argentina, Costa Rica, France, the Sudan, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Republic of Tanzania and the United States of America. In accordance with paragraph 7 of the terms of reference of the Committee, the vacancies are to be filled as follows:

- (a) Two members from African States;
- (b) Two members from Latin American States;
- (c) One member from socialist States of Eastern Europe;
- (d) Two members from Western European and other States.

4. By its decision 1982/126 of 6 May 1982, the Economic and Social Council nominated the following Member States for election by the General Assembly at its thirty-seventh session, for a term of three years, beginning on 1 January 1983:

- (a) African States: Ethiopia and Nigeria;
- (b) Latin American States: Argentina and Chile;
- (c) Socialist States of Eastern Europe: Union of Soviet Socialist Republics;
- (d) Western European and other States: France and the United States of America.
