Further to my letter of 15 July 1982 (A/37/344-S/15298), I have the honour to draw your attention to the fact that the Hanoi authorities, pursuing their war of aggression and genocide, have sent new troop reinforcements to Kampuchea. detailed information annexed hereto was broadcast by "Voice of Democratic Kampuchea" radio.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter and information distributed as an official document of the General Assembly, under item 20 of the provisional agenda, and of the Security Council.

ANNEX CONTRACTOR CONTRACTOR REPORTS

HANOI DISPATCHES FRESH SUPPLY OF TROOPS TO KAMPUCHEA

- 1. From 20 June to 10 July 1982, 130 trucks transporting fresh supply of troops were sent to Siemreap province by the aggressor Le Duan clique. These troops were transported from Vietnamese province of Tay Ninh, passing the Kampuchean province of Kompong Cham through Road No. 22 and arrived in Staung, Kompong Thom province. 3,000 Vietnamese soldiers of these reinforcements were then sent to the districts of Chikreng and Siemreap, province of Siemreap while the other 1,000 continued their way toward the Western region along national highway 6.
- 2. On 13 July, another 10 trucks transporting 300 new Vietnamese soldiers were sent from Vietnam to Thmar Puok district, Sisophon front, North of national highway 5. Upon their arrival in Phum Mkak village, these troops were disposed in echelon from Phum Sangha up to Phum Sla Kram.
- 3. On 15 July, the Le Duan clique sent from Vietnam another contingent of 400 soldiers to Phnom Srok district, Battambang province. These soldiers were dispatched as follows: 100 at Sangkat Nam Tav; 100 at Kauk Rumdeng; 100 at Phum Svay Sar, and 100 at Sangkat Ta Vorng.
- 4. On 16 July, coming from the Vietnamese province of Hatien by road from Toan Han, 5 trucks carrying new fresh supply of troops arrived at Kompong Trach, Kompot province.

It should be reminded that 20,000 Vietnamese soldiers were already sent in reinforcement to Kampuchea last May.

These fresh supplies of Vietnamese troops clearly deny the announcement of the so-called "partial withdrawal" of Vietnamese troops made recently by Nguyen Co Thach in Saigon to fool the world public opinion. It exposes the perfidy of the Le Duan clique. When it speaks of withdrawal of troops, that means it is sending new reinforcements. When it speaks of peace, that means it is preparing war.
