Administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution contained in document T/L.1231

Statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 65 of the rules of procedure of the Trusteeship Council

- 1. Pursuant to preambular paragraphs 1 and 3 of the draft resolution contained in document T/L.1231, the Trusteeship Council would decide to dispatch a visiting mission to the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands in July 1982 for a period of approximately four weeks. Under operative paragraph 5 of the draft resolution, the Secretary-General would be requested to provide the necessary staff and facilities to assist the visiting mission in the performance of its functions.
- It is the understanding of the Secretary-General that the mission would consist of two members of the Council and would be serviced by five staff members of the Secretariat.
- 3. The Secretary-General wishes to state that based on the above-mentioned arrangements, the total estimated costs of dispatching the mission would amount to \$44,200. The total amount of the resources currently allocated for the programme of work of the Trusteeship Council in 1982 is \$41,300.
