Text of a note from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China to the Embassy of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam in China, dated 12 September 1982

Two MIGs 21 of the Vietnamese Air Force intruded into China's territorial air over Ningming county and Pingxiang city, Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region, to conduct reconnaissance from 11:46 hours to 11:48 hours on 10 September 1982. This was a serious premeditated provocation by the Vietnamese authorities. It again shows that the proposal made by the Vietnamese Foreign Ministry on 14 August regarding the so-called cessation of hostile activities along the Sino-Vietnamese border during the national days of the two countries is hypocritical, and that it is nothing but a smokescreen laid by the Vietnamese authorities to cover up their intensified efforts to create tension along the Sino-Vietnamese border.

The Chinese Government lodges a strong protest with the Vietnamese authorities for their sending military aircraft to intrude into China's territorial air space and solemnly demands that the Vietnamese side immediately stop all its provocations against and intrusions into the Chinese border areas. Otherwise, the Vietnamese authorities must be held totally responsible for all the consequences arising therefrom.
