STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/1999/25 of 15 January 1999, S/1999/25/Add.2 of 29 January 1999, S/1999/25/Add.5 of 19 February 1999, S/1999/25/Add.11 of 1 April 1999, S/1999/25/Add.17 of 14 May 1999 and S/1999/25/Add.22 of 18 June 1999.

During the week ending 24 July 1999, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Admission of new Members (see S/1999/25/Add.17 and 24)

By a note dated 16 July 1999 (S/1999/793), the Secretary-General circulated the application of the Kingdom of Tonga for admission to membership in the United Nations, contained in a letter dated 8 July 1999 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Defence of the Kingdom of Tonga addressed to the Secretary-General.

The Security Council considered the application of the Kingdom of Tonga for admission to membership in the United Nations at its 4024th meeting, on 22 July 1999.

At that meeting, in accordance with rule 59 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council and in the absence of a proposal to the contrary, the President of the Security Council referred the application of the Kingdom of Tonga to the Committee on the Admission on New Members for examination and report.
