Convention on jurisdictional immunities of States and their property

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 53/98 of 8 December 1998,

Having considered the report of the Working Group of the International Law Commission on jurisdictional immunities of States and their property, annexed to the report of the Commission on the work of its fifty-first session,¹

Having considered the oral report made to the Committee by the Chairman² of the open-ended working group of the Sixth Committee established under its resolution 53/98 of 8 December 1998,

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General,³

1. *Takes note with appreciation* of the report of the Working Group of the International Law Commission on jurisdictional immunities of States and their property annexed to the report of the International Law Commission on the work of its fifty-first session;¹

2. *Urges* States, if they have not yet done so, to submit their comments to the Secretary-General in accordance with resolution 49/61 of 9 December 1994 and also invites States to submit in writing to the Secretary-General, by 1 August 2000, their comments on the above-mentioned report of the Working Group;

3. *Decides* that the open-ended working group of the Sixth Committee established under its resolution 53/98 of 8 December 1998 will continue its work at its fifty-fifth session to consider the future form of, and outstanding substantive issues related to, the

draft articles on jurisdictional immunities of States and their property adopted by the International Law Commission;

4. *Also decides* to include in the provisional agenda of its fifty-fifth session the item entitled “Convention on jurisdictional immunities of States and their property”.
