LETTER DATED 18 NOVEMBER 1999 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF GEORGIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Annex

Statement issued on 17 November 1999 by the Ministry
of Foreign Affairs of Georgia

On 17 November 1999 at 12.10 p.m. local time the air space of Georgia near the village of Shatili was violated by three military helicopters of the air forces of the Russian Federation, which shot at the settlements in the region of Mutso Gorge. The nearby territory where a unit of the Border Guard Forces of Georgia was deployed was also shot at.

The above-mentioned act, which cannot be assessed otherwise but as direct aggression against a sovereign State, is a continuation of the purposeful anti-Georgian propaganda campaign being carried out by certain circles in the higher echelons of the authorities of the Russian Federation in their attempt to involve Georgia in the Caucasian war at any cost.

In connection with the above-mentioned fact of aggression, the Georgian side expresses its resolute protest, addressing its demand to the leadership of the Russian Federation to put an end to aggressive acts against sovereign Georgia and also to identify and hold responsible the officials who have planned and carried out this criminal act.
