SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/13033 of 9 January 1979.

During the week ending 23 June 1979, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Letters dated 13 June 1979 and 15 June 1979 from the Permanent Representative of Morocco to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

In a letter dated 13 June 1979 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/13394), the representative of Morocco charged that between 31 May and 4 June Morocco had been the victim of two flagrant attacks carried out and directed by forces whose point of departure was situated in neighbouring Algerian territory, and requested that the necessary arrangements be made to convene a meeting of the Security Council to consider the matter.

In a letter dated 15 June addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/13397), the representative of Morocco stated that a further act of aggression had occurred, and requested that the Security Council be convened urgently to consider the situation.

At its 2151st meeting on 20 June, the Security Council included the item in its agenda, and continued its discussion at its 2152nd and 2153rd meetings, held on 21 and 22 June.

In the course of the meetings, the President, with the consent of the Council invited the representatives of Algeria, Benin, the Congo, Democratic Yemen, Madagascar, Mauritania, Morocco and Zaire, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the request dated 20 June 1979 from Afghanistan, Algeria, Benin, Burundi, the Congo, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Guyana, Madagascar, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe and the United Republic of Tanzania (S/13406), the Council agreed, at its 2151st meeting, to extend an invitation under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure to Mr. Madjid Abdallah.
