NOTE VERBALE DATED 6 JULY 1979 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE UKRAINIAN SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLIC TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and in connexion with his note PO 230 SOAF (2-2-4) of 21 March 1979 concerning compliance with Security Council resolutions 418 (1977) and 421 (1977) has the honour to state the following.

In accordance with its position of principle on this question, the Ukrainian SSR is strictly and fully complying with the resolutions of the United Nations Security Council concerning a voluntary arms embargo against the racist régime of South Africa and has no relations of a political, economic, military or other character with that régime.

The Permanent Mission of the Ukrainian SSR also wishes to draw attention to reports in the mass media to the effect that a number of Western countries are continuing to deliver a variety of arms to the Republic of South Africa. Such acts not only violate resolutions of the United Nations Security Council on the arms embargo against South Africa, but also heighten military tension in the southern part of the African continent, which constitutes a threat to the general peace and security of peoples.

The Permanent Mission of the Ukrainian SSR to the United Mations requests that this note should be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
