## Letter from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Jordan to the Secretary-General

The Government of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan expressed its deep indignation, disgust and dismay at the appalling and heinous massacre of Palestinian civilians, women and children in Beirut.

This mass murder of innocent civilian population is only a series in Israel's tactics and methods, beginning with Deir Yasin, Qibiya and now Beirut. Israel's scare tactics arising from murder of peaceful people is once again employed in Lebanon in order to intimidate and disperse the Palestinians, as it has done previously in Palestine, and to put into effect its own plan and design aiming at the prevention of national reconciliation and the restoration of a stable Lebanon.

Israel is cultivating the state of chaos, destruction and fear it created, in order to rationalize its continued occupation of Lebanon and victimizing the Lebanese and the Palestinians there.

In declaring national mourning over these atrocities and crimes against humanity, the Government of Jordan invites the world community to shed their indifference and join responsibly to stop these horrendous crimes as they had courageously done decades ago.
