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LETTER DATED 20 OCTOBER 1982 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ARGENTINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government and with reference to my note of 23 September 1982 (S/15427) and previous notes, I have the honour to report to you further acts of harassment carried out by British vessels and aircraft against Argentine fishing vessels; all these incidents occurred outside the so-called "protection zone" arbitrarily and unilaterally established by the United Kingdom Government.

The events referred to are the following:

On 10 September - 1950 hours GMT - at latitude 52°37' south and longitude 63°26' west, seven miles outside the "protection zone", the fishing vessel <u>Usurbil</u> was buzzed by a Westland Sea Lynx WG 13 military helicopter with British markings.

On 11 September - 1144 hours GMT - at latitude 52°38' south and longitude 63°36' west, eight miles outside the "protection zone", the fishing vessel Api IV was overflown by an olive green military helicopter with British markings. Similar action took place over the remainder of the Argentine fishing fleet.

On 11 September - 1150 hours GMT - at latitude 52°33' south and longitude 63°34' west approximately eight miles outside the "protection zone", a British helicopter circled above the fishing vessel Rokko Maru.

On 11 September - 1140 hours GMT - at latitude 52°37' south and longitude 63°27' west some 10 miles outside the "protection zone", the fishing vessel <u>Usurbil</u> was buzzed by a Westland Sea Lyn WG 13 with British markings.

On 11 September - 1140 GMT - at latitude 52°35' south and longitude 63°39' west some 15 miles outside the "protection zone", the fishing vessels Api II and Api IV were overflown by a British military helicopter.

On 11 September - 1130 hours GMT - at latitude 52°31' south and longitude 63°32' west, some 15 miles outside the "protection zone", the fishing vessels Api III and Api IV were overflown by a Sea King helicopter at an altitude of 60 metres.

- On 15 September 2220 hours GMT at latitude 52°53' south and longitude 64°10' west, approximately 45 miles outside the "protection zone", the fishing vessel Corcubión was overflown by a helicopter.
- On 15 September 2055 hours GMT at latitude 52°49' south and longitude 63°35' west, approximately 25 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessel Rivera Gallega was buzzed by an olive-green military helicopter with British markings.
- On 15 September 2105 hours GMT at latitude 52°39' south and longitude 63°52' west, approximately 10 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessels <u>Urquil</u> and <u>Usurbil</u> were overflown by a military helicopter with British markings.
- On 15 September 2115 hours GMT at latitude 53°02' south and longitude 64°15' west, more than 30 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessel Caaveiro was overflown by a Sea King helicopter gunship with British markings.
- On 15 September 2110 hours GMT at latitude 52°56' south and longitude 63°37' west, at the outer limit of the protection zone, the vessel Api II was buzzed by a British military helicopter.
- On 18 September 2030 hours GMT at latitude 52'45' south and longitude 64'25' west, 30 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessels <u>Kasuga Maru</u> and <u>Rokko Maru</u> were overflown by a British military helicopter at an altitude of 20 metres.
- On 18 September 2000 hours GMT at latitude 52'39' south and longitude 64'17' west, 30 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessel Api III was overflown at low altitude by a British military helicopter.
- On 18 September 2025 hours GMT at latitude 52°40' south and longitude 64°13' west, 32 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessel Rivera Gallega was buzzed by an olive-green Sea Lynx military helicopter with British markings.
- On 18 September 2025 hours GMT at latitude 52°39' south and longitude 64°20' west, 30 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessel <u>Usurbil</u> was buzzed by a Westland Lynx WG 13 military helicopter.
- On 18 September 2020 hours GMT at latitude 52°40' south and longitude 64°15' west, 30 miles outside the protection zone, the fishing vessels <u>Caaveiro</u> and Corcubion were buzzed by a Sea King helicopter gunship, with British markings.
