LETTER DATED 2 NOVEMBER 1982 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE SEYCHELLES TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have been requested by my Government to inform the Security Council of a matter of grave concern which threatens the peace and security of the Republic of Seychelles.

Recent reports of repeated external attempts to destabilize economically and to overthrow violently the legitimate Government of the Republic of Seychelles evidence a persistent and determined effort to violate the Charter of the United Nations.

In the event that these activities continue, the Government of the Republic of Seychelles reserves the right to bring this matter to the Council's attention by requesting an immediate convening of the Security Council.

I should be grateful if you would arrange for this letter to be circulated as a document of the Security Council under the item "Complaint by Seychelles".
