Insert after paragraph 28 the following additional paragraph:

28A. In response to paragraph 269 of the Programme of Action for the Second Half of the United Nations Decade for Women, the Department of Public Information is continuing its radio programme series "Women" in three languages. The English programmes are produced weekly and the French and Spanish programmes twice monthly. The programmes cover all United Nations activities as they relate to women. In addition to regular distribution, the English and French programmes are broadcast daily over short wave transmissions to African countries. The distribution of tapes and scripts has increased steadily and there are now approximately 600 radio stations and organizations broadcasting the programmes. Local adaptations of the programmes into further languages are facilitated by the Department. The scripts of the programmes are often used as written informational material for articles, newsletters, and education and literacy programmes. The Department of Public Information is co-producing a film in connexion with the United Nations Decade for Women which will be completed in 1983.
