Letter dated 1 November 1982 from the Permanent Representative of Iran to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Pursuant to the letter dated 28 October 1982 (A/37/584-S/15471), I have the honour to bring to your attention the latest development in the Iraqi aggression against the Islamic Republic of Iran.

On 30 October 1982, the Iraqi long-range artillery once again targeted residential areas in Abadan, destroying several houses and causing great human sufferings. This savage bombardment is not only contrary to the principles of international law, but also, for the second time in three days, proves the Iraqi violation of paragraph 1 of their own resolution imposed upon the General Assembly a week ago.

It would be highly appreciated if the text of this letter is distributed as an official document of the General Assembly under agenda items 58, 118, 122 and 134, and of the Security Council.
