Letter dated 2 May 1988 from the Permanent Representative  
of Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the  
Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 28 April 1988 (A/43/342-S/19850), I have the honour to report to you the following incidents in violation of Pakistan territory from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 25 April and 27 April 1988:

On 25 April 1988 at 0915 hours three Afghan fighter aircraft violated Pakistan airspace by approximately 2 kilometres and dropped four bombs in the area approximately 3 kilometres west of Teri Mangal in the Kurram Agency. As a result, four Afghan refugees were killed and three injured.

On 27 April 1988 at 1650 hours, the Afghan armed forces fired 16 rounds of mortar which landed in Landi Khana in the Khyber Agency. As a result, nine persons were killed including one child (Pakistan national) and eight Afghan refugees and 14 injured including three Pakistan nationals and 11 Afghan refugees.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was called to the Foreign Office on the morning of 2 May 1988 and a strong protest was lodged with him over the unprovoked attacks. He was asked to inform the authorities in Kabul that if such attacks did not cease the entire responsibility for the serious consequences would rest on them.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under items 30, 72, 130, 134 and 137 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
