Page 28-30, first paragraph

Should read

We should recall that the Security Council met earlier this year, in January, also at the request of Lebanon, and that at that time it considered the deterioration of the situation in southern Lebanon as a result of the continued acts of aggression and barbarous repression committed by the Israeli occupation forces against the people of Lebanon and the inroads upon the sovereignty and territorial integrity of that country owing to Israel's continued occupation of a part of its territory. It is clear to all that the aim of the repression to which I have just referred is identical to the repression that is occurring today. The goal is to create a state of psychosis that will compel the inhabitants of southern Lebanon to abandon their lands and property, thereby draining the area of its population and giving a free hand to the expansionist policy drawn up by world Zionist conferences, to be implemented by Israel, the executive agent. These actions confirm that Zionist ambitions in southern Lebanon are aimed, inter alia, at its water resources. Everyone knows that the establishment of a so-called security zone on Lebanese soil is the concrete manifestation of those ambitions.
