Dear Sir.

On behalf of the Congress of Canadian Women, Windsor Chapter, we urge you to investigate and bring before the peoples the crimes which the women of the Cameroons bring against their Government.

On August 13 last, the Cameroonian Women's Democratic Union was dissolved. During the summer the village of Ngambo was destroyed and the population massacred. At Douglas, at Nkangsamba, at Babimbi ... women were dragged from their beds and beaten into insensiblity ...

At letter from these women dated August 27, states that "UNO arranged for an inspection ... to investigate the sources and causes of the civil troubles of last May", but that "an atmosphere of terror was created to prevent patriots from upproaching the members of the mission".

We beg for support for these women, so that they may feel the United Nations 'harter does not exist in words alone.
