STATE OF SIEGE IN CAMEROONS AGGRAVATED BY FRENCH AUTHORITIES IN PREPARATION ARRIVAL VISITING MISSION STOP DURING MARKET AT BABADJOU YESTERDAY FOUR LORRY LOADS OF SOLDIERS ARRIVED THREE DAYS BEFORE CARRIED OUT MASS ARRESTS OF PATRIOTS SUBJECTED THEM INCLUDING MOTHER AND BABY TO INHUMAN TORTURE PILLAGED PROPERTY WORTH SEVERAL MILLION FRANCS MAN HUNT CONTINUES CUSTOMS CONTROL TIGHTENED UP STOP REQUEST MAKE REPRESENTATIONS TO FRENCH GOVERNMENT TO ENSURE RESPECT UNIVERSAL LECLARATION HUMAN RIGHTS
