We, members of the Zoatubsi Local Committee (30 men and 12 women),  
meeting at Zoatubsi, having been informed of the summons received by our  
General Secretary, Ruben Un Nyobe, to appear before the Examining Magistrate  
at Yaoundé for a purely political matter, protest against this political  
decision of which our General Secretary is a victim.

We vigorously denounce the abuses which have been the subject of complaints  
legally transmitted by our General Secretary and which have remained unanswered.
