

THE WORLD CALENDAR

ESTIMATE PRESENTED BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
IN ACCORDANCE WITH FINANCIAL REGULATION
NO. 25 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The draft resolution submitted by the Representative of Peru on the appointment of an ad hoc committee to study the World Calendar will involve direct additional expenditures not foreseen in the United Nations Budget for 1947. Assuming a minimum staff of one additional consultant or staff member for six months plus temporary secretarial assistance and the cost of travel of five members of the ad hoc committee, the estimated cost in 1947 is approximately \$13,050.
