Sir,

Kamerun under French administration in danger. Mass slaughter of
Kameronians by French military forces. More than one thousand (1,000) already
killed on 27 and 28 December at Log Dikit-Edéa (Sanaga Maritime). Soldiers
armed with machine guns and other weapons still surrounding our Subdivision
day and night.

Request your urgent intervention. Request immediate Unification and
Independence of our Territory.
