PETITION FROM Mr. BASILE WAFO CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

To the President of the eleventh session of the General Assembly of the United Nations, New York, USA

In this family petition, I and my wife have the honour to request your good will in the following matter: my wife, Julienne Kakapping, gave birth on 25 December 1956 to a son, and the French colonialists killed the child on about 9 January 1957 at Benssoa, Dschang subdivision. Their reason was that the child was named after Momie Felix, who led the UFC in Kamerun on that day when blood flowed everywhere and the French colonialists killed pregnant women and children. They killed everyone in Kamerun. We request the immediate unification and independence of the Kamerun. Kamerun is our native land, the tomb of our forefathers.

Hurrah for the eleventh session, hurrah for peace and hurrah for the unity and independence of Kamerun.

We have the honour, etc.
