PETITION FROM THE BALESSENG LOCAL COMMITTEE OF THE "UNION DES POPULATIONS DU CAMEROUN" CONCERNING THE CAMEROONS UNDER FRENCH ADMINISTRATION

Subject: Petition

To the Secretary-General of the United Nations General Assembly, New York Sir,

I have the honour respectfully to bring to your attention the following facts:

- 1. The French subject the Cameroonians and their Group Chiefs to daily torture. It is you, who are responsible for whites and blacks, that can take decisions restraining the abuses of these Authorities. The Cameroons were once a single country. When the Germans left, the French and English divided it between them without consulting the Cameroonian population. The partition of our country into two Territories is thus entirely fraudulent. We therefore ask that we should be granted Unification and Independence within the shortest possible time.
- 2. On 23 November 1956 the Chief of the village of Baham, Subdivision of Bafoussam, was arrested and taken to Dschang, from where he was transferred to Yaoundé and brought before the High Commissioner of the French Republic in the Cameroons on a criminal charge: that he was an active member of the <u>Union</u>
 des Populations du Camroun. On the day of his arrest the local Administration of this Subdivision proposed a new Chief without consulting the nine notables

responsible for the appointment of Group Chiefs in the Bamiléké Region. Such a procedure is unthinkable in the Bamiléké Region. You too are aware, Mr. Secretary. General, that in the Bamiléké Region the Group Chiefs are appointed by the nine notables of each Group and in accordance with the will of the deceased chief proposing his last legitimate son as successor. It is with regret, therefore, that for the first time we see a Group Chief in our Region appointed by the Administration in the place of the young Chief who inherited the property of his father only three years ago.
